Day-1, 14/06/2024

Inauguration Ceremony - 10:00 am-10:30 am The workshop was inaugurated by the esteemed guests: Shri. Sajjankaka Raorane, Hon. Chairman, Local Management Committee, Maharana Pratapsinh Shikshan Sanstha; Shri. Sharadchandra Raorane, Hon. Trustee, Maharana Pratapsinh Shikshan Sanstha; Dr. Ravindra Bambardekar, Principal, Model College, Dombivali; Dr. Madhav Rajwade, Principal, PVT A’ Sathye College, Mumbai; Dr. Hiren Dand, Head, IT Department; Dr. Pandurang Patil, Head, Mumbai University Subcenter, Ratnagiri; and Dr. C. S. Kakade, Principal, Anandibai Raorane Arts, Commerce & Science College, Vaibhavwadi. Mr. S. B. Patil, Coordinator of the workshop, presented the introductory speech and explained the purpose and nature of the workshop. The workshop was inaugurated with a grand opening ceremony. It began with the national anthem, instilling a sense of patriotism among the attendees. This was followed by the soulful rendition of the Maharashtra Geet, celebrating the rich cultural heritage of the state. The event concluded with the university song, fostering a sense of unity and pride among the students and faculty. The honorable guests present on the stage gave their best wishes to the workshop. Dr. C. S. Kakade, Principal of the college and Chairperson of the Inauguration Ceremony, delivered his Presidential Speech, in which he discussed the various phases of the National Education Policy-

2020 Sensitization Programme and the importance of the National Education Policy-2020. Dr. D. M. Sirsat, proposed the Vote of Thanks and inaugural function is concluded.

Session-I, 10:30 am to 12:00 pm for Non-Teaching Staff

Resource Person of the Session: Dr. Ravindra Bambardekar, Principal, Model College, Dombivali

The workshop held on 14th June 2024, attended by forty nine members of the non-teaching staff from various colleges in Sindhudurg district, focused on the National Education Policy-2020. Dr. Ravindra Bambardekar emphasized the importance of understanding the nature and scope of the policy for all stakeholders in education. He discussed the reasons for the policy's emergence, its student-centric nature, and the crucial role of non-teaching staff in its effective implementation. Dr. Hiren Dand, Head of the IT Department, provided detailed information about the new admission portal and explained the system of the Academic Bank of Credits, highlighting its significance in students' academic lives and result processing. The session concluded with a question-and-answer segment, where a panel of experts, including Dr. Bambardekar, Dr. Madhav Rajwade, and Dr. Dand, addressed the participants' queries and doubts.

Speaker II - Dr. Madhav Rajwade, for students

Session time: 1:00 pm - 3:00 pm

A workshop on 14th June 2024 gathered one hundred twenty students from various colleges in Sindhudurg district to explore the National Education Policy-2020 (NEP-2020). Dr. Ravindra Bambardekar stressed the significance of comprehending the policy's student-centric approach and the pivotal role of non-teaching staff in its execution. Dr. Hiren Dand, Head of the IT Department, provided detailed insights into the new admission portal and the Academic Bank of Credits system, emphasizing their impact on students' academic journeys. Dr. Madhav Rajwade delivered an outstanding lecture, elucidating NEP-2020's flexibility in allowing students to select subjects across different faculties and study two languages. He outlined the credit system, which mandates students to achieve a minimum of 22 credits per semester and 24 credits annually, with provisions for flexible entry and exit points. The workshop concluded with a panel discussion featuring Dr. Bambardekar, Dr. Rajwade, and Dr. Dand, addressing student queries to ensure a thorough understanding of NEP-2020 and its implementation.

Speaker III - Dr. Hiran Dand for parents

Dr. Hiren Dand provided crucial guidance to forty parents during the workshop. Parents from neighboring colleges in Sindhudurg district also attended the workshop. They focusing on the

importance of maintaining consistency with their mobile numbers and linking them to Aadhaar cards. He underscored the significance of generating an ABC ID (Academic Bank Credit) accurately, stressing its role in facilitating seamless academic transactions. Dr. Dand further elaborated on the online registration process through the Samarth portal, scheduled to commence from June 20, outlining the steps for admission and the subsequent announcement of merit lists. During the interactive session, Dr. Dand effectively addressed numerous questions from participants, particularly resolving doubts raised by parents regarding the implementation of the National Education Policy. His comprehensive responses ensured clarity and understanding among all attendees regarding the policy's implications and operational procedures.

Day Two: Session: Prof. R.D. Kulkarni (V.C., University of Mumbai) for Teachers

In the inaugural session of the second day, Vice-chancellor Prof. R.D. Kulkarni delved deeply into the nuances of NEP-2020, showcasing Mumbai University's proactive measures in its adoption and implementation. He elaborated on the university's extensive initiatives, which included organizing 22 comprehensive workshops and engaging with over 3,700 professors. Additionally, the university reached out to 1,200 junior colleges and schools through the School Connect Programme. Vice-chancellor Prof. R.D. Kulkarni highlighted the central tenets of NEP-2020, particularly its emphasis on increasing flexibility for students and educational institutions alike. He underscored the significance of cultivating industry awareness among both students and educators, recognizing this as a crucial element in equipping students to face real-world challenges.

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 also aims to incorporate vocational skills relevant to each discipline. We have identified these skills by subject and integrated them into the academic curricula. For this initiative, feedback from the industry is essential to ensure a strong connection with the industrial sector. The industry, mainly comprising manufacturing and service sectors, holds the potential to offer employment opportunities for students. Collaboration between academia and industry is crucial to understand the specific skills needed, which can then be included in the academic programs. Additionally, NEP 2020 emphasizes the importance of On-the-Job Training (OJT), making active industry participation a prerequisite for the policy's success. The vocational education component of the NEP is vital as it provides hands-on training. To meet the goals of OJT and internships, academic curricula need to be flexible.

During his presentation, Vice-chancellor Prof. R.D. Kulkarni introduced Mumbai University's innovative M1, M2, and M3 models, which are designed to promote interdisciplinary learning by facilitating the exchange of core subjects across various disciplines. This strategy aims to encourage collaboration among colleges and universities, thereby enriching the overall

educational experience. The workshop was attended by 150 teachers and featured dynamic discussions on the introduction of open elective courses and the six verticals outlined in the educational policies. Participants engaged in thoughtful deliberations on how to integrate these elements into curriculum planning, with a particular focus on fostering students' personality development.

Vice-chancellor Prof. R.D. Kulkarni concluded by reaffirming the workshop's commitment to the effective implementation of NEP-2020, with the goal of creating a more dynamic and inclusive educational environment at Mumbai University and beyond. He emphasized the importance of these initiatives in ensuring that the university remains at the forefront of educational innovation, ultimately benefiting both students and educators.

Day Two: Session: II and III, Dr. Ravindra Bambardekar and Dr. Hiren Dand for College Management and others

A comprehensive session was conducted by Dr. Ravindra Bambardekar and Dr. Hiren Dand, aiming to provide an in-depth understanding of NEP-2020 and elucidate the roles of management and various stakeholders in adapting to the new policy framework. This session was attended by a total of forty-eight participants, comprising twenty management personnel and twenty-eight individuals from other sectors.

Dr. Bambardekar and Dr. Dand delivered their presentations with remarkable smoothness and precision, making complex concepts accessible to all attendees. They meticulously covered the key aspects of NEP-2020, emphasizing its transformative potential within the education sector. Their explanations highlighted the significance of collaborative efforts among educators, administrators, and community members in successfully implementing the policy. They stressed that such collective action is crucial for achieving the desired outcomes of NEP-2020. Throughout the session, both presenters used clear examples and practical illustrations to ensure that participants could grasp the nuances of the new policy. They also provided actionable insights into how different stakeholders can contribute to the policy's implementation, thus fostering an environment of shared responsibility and cooperation.

The workshop concluded with a heartfelt vote of thanks delivered by Dr. M. I. Kumbhar. Dr. Kumbhar expressed his gratitude to the speakers for their enlightening presentations and to the participants for their active engagement and valuable contributions. He acknowledged the efforts of all involved in making the session a success and highlighted the importance of continued dialogue and collaboration in the journey towards effective NEP-2020 implementation.
